AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

A BILL to amend and reenact § 51.5-116 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 10 of Chapter 14 of Title 51.5 a section numbered 51.5-169.1, relating to Long-Term Employment Support Services and Extended Employment Services.

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That § 51.5-116 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 10 of Chapter 14 of Title 51.5 a section numbered 51.5-169.1 as follows:**

**§ 51.5-116. Definitions.**

As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:

"Case management" means a dynamic collaborative process that utilizes and builds on the strengths and resources of consumers to assist them in identifying their needs, accessing and coordinating services, and achieving their goals. The major collaborative components of case management services include advocacy, assessment, planning, facilitation, coordination, and monitoring.

"Case management system" means a central point of contact linking a wide variety of evolving services and supports that are (i) available in a timely, coordinated manner; (ii) physically and programmatically accessible; and (iii) consumer-directed with procedural safeguards to ensure responsiveness and accountability.

"Client" means any person receiving a service provided by the personnel or facilities of a public or private agency, whether referred to as a client, participant, patient, resident, or other term.

"Commissioner" means the Commissioner for Aging and Rehabilitative Services.

26 "Consumer" means, with respect to case management services, a person with a disability or his  
27 designee, guardian, conservator, or committee.

28 "Department" means the Department for Aging and Rehabilitative Services.

29 "Employment services organization" means an organization that provides employment services to  
30 individuals with disabilities that is an approved Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities  
31 (CARF) accredited vendor of the Department.

32 "Local board" means a local board of social services established pursuant to Article 1 (§ 63.2-300  
33 et seq.) of Chapter 3 of Title 63.2.

34 "Local department" means a local department of social services established pursuant to Article 2  
35 (§ 63.2-324 et seq.) of Chapter 3 of Title 63.2.

36 "Local director" means a local director of social services appointed pursuant to § 63.2-325.

37 "Older person" or "older Virginian" means a person who is age 60 years or older.

38 "Physical or sensory disability" means a disability resulting in functional impairment or  
39 impairment of the central nervous system, which may include but is not limited to brain injury, spinal cord  
40 injury, cerebral palsy, arthritis, muscular dystrophy, multiple sclerosis, Prader-Willi syndrome, and  
41 systemic lupus erythematosus (lupus).

42 "Prader-Willi syndrome" means a specific disorder that is usually caused by chromosomal change,  
43 resulting in lifelong functional and cognitive impairments and life-threatening obesity.

44 "Rehabilitation technology" means the systematic application of technologies, engineering  
45 methodologies, or scientific principles to meet the needs of and address the barriers confronted by  
46 individuals with disabilities in areas that include education, rehabilitation, employment, transportation,  
47 independent living, and recreation.

48 § 51.5-169.1. Long-Term Employment Support Services and Extended Employment  
49 Services.

50 A. Long-Term Employment Support Services and Extended Employment Services shall be  
51 provided in the Commonwealth to assist individuals with a significant disability or most significant

52 disability with maintaining employment. The Department shall administer and make referrals for such  
53 services in accordance with the provisions of this section.

54 B. Long-Term Employment Support Services shall be provided to individuals with a most  
55 significant disability, as defined in 29 U.S.C. § 705, to assist such individuals with maintaining group-  
56 supported employment or individual center-based, facility-based, or community-based employment  
57 through an employment services organization.

58 All employment services organizations that provide group-supported, center-based, facility-based,  
59 or community-based employment services to individuals with a most significant disability shall be eligible  
60 to receive funding for Long-Term Employment Support Services.

61 C. Extended Employment Services shall be provided to individuals with a most significant  
62 disability and individuals with a significant disability, as those terms are defined in 29 U.S.C. § 705, to  
63 assist such individuals with maintaining group-supported employment or individual center-based or  
64 facility-based employment through an employment services organization. Extended Employment Services  
65 funds may also be used to support such individuals that transition from group-supported, center-based, or  
66 facility-based employment into community-based employment. Extended Employment Services shall be  
67 provided upon the informed choice of the individual being served and in accordance with the  
68 Commonwealth's Employment First initiative, federal law and regulation, and the Commonwealth's  
69 August 23, 2012, settlement agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice.

70 All employment services organizations that provide group-supported, center-based, or facility-  
71 based employment services to individuals with a most significant disability or individuals with a  
72 significant disability, or that provide community-based employment services to such individuals  
73 transitioning from group-supported, center-based, or facility-based employment, shall be eligible to  
74 receive funding for Extended Employment Services. The Department shall make referrals to any such  
75 employment services organization that provides competitive or commensurate wages.

76 D. In allocating funds for Long-Term Employment Support Services and Extended Employment  
77 Services, the Department shall consider recommendations made by the Employment Service Organization  
78 Steering Committee.
